Regional Coordinator

Fostering Family Ministries is a coalition of churches committed to finding a loving home for every child in foster care, to see God set the lonely in our families (Psalm 68:6). In order to see our vision of a church for every child become a reality, each partner church has a Champion that engages and equips their church to cultivate a culture that cares for vulnerable children, particularly by supporting foster & kinship families and the children placed in their homes. We are looking for someone who is passionate about seeing vulnerable children placed in loving homes that will help encourage, coordinate, and train the champions in their county.

A successful Regional Coordinator will:

- Be a devoted follower of Jesus Christ, daily acknowledging Him as Lord and Savior and an active member in good standing of a Gospel centered local church
- Help recruit churches to become partners with FFM and launch family affirming ministry to foster children
- Encourage Champions in their efforts to inspire and equip their church to recruit Foster Families and wrap care teams around Foster & Kinship Families
- Actively provide monthly coaching in person and by phone & quarterly update in person meetings
- Assist in leading the Church Champion Clinic both in person and virtual (take Train the Trainer and co lead before taking full responsibility)
- Help connect and wrap Care Teams from partner churches around Foster & Kinship Families who are not part of a local church
- Collect and share success stories from churches foster care ministries to be shared
- Share material needs with partner churches and if applicable support the technical implementation of CarePortal to share material needs in a county
- Pursue funding opportunities and church support and work with Director on submission of private grant proposals available in the community
- Coordinate regional participation in the Color Fun (May) during Foster Care Appreciation Month, Made for Home Banquet Series (September) and Pure Religion Sunday as well as any other joint awareness, recruitment or support raising efforts (Parent's Night Out, Foster/Kinship family celebrations etc...)
- Use their skills and passions to add to the exceptional work and equipping of the Champion team
