This year we had the opportunity to start our Xander sensory stuffed animal distribution to children in foster care in 4 counties so far: Ashland, Knox, Medina & Richland. Every stuffed animal gives us precious encounters with families and children in foster care. One story captured my heart.

After admiring a foster family's sweet little baby, I began to chat with them as they picked up a few Xanders for their foster children. They started to share about this infant's journey to their home, I suddenly realized I was now privileged to witness the **"rest of the story"**. A story that began nearly a year before when this baby's life had first been conceived.

The previous year we were able to provide significant support to get a child to kinship grandparents. FFM & our coalition of churches are often called upon to support families in the child placing process. You all stepped up in amazing ways! As a result of that service, the door was opened to help the birth momma in her crisis.

This first momma reached out to FFM and was provided with safety, shelter, and care through partnership with community ministries. In that environment, she discovered new little life was growing within her. Now, being surrounded with support, she considered her two choices. **She chose life...this life.**

The sleepy baby in front of me was peacefully resting in safe arms because of churches caring for vulnerable children and families, including birth moms and dads.

Xander Bunnies for Kids



TBRI Caregiver Training



FFM's has offered TBRI (trauma competent) coalition of churches. training to our communities, foster kinship parents, and teachers, counselors, law enforcement and legal professionals since 2016. This past year, with the support of the Samaritan Hospital Foundation we partnered Ashland Juvenile Court Judge Karen DeSanto Kellogg to offer a series of Lunch & Learn's and several 4 day TBRI trainings in preparation for the 2 day training led by Judge Clark's court team from Texas who implemented TBRI in their court for improved family outcomes.

TBRI Caregiver: 4 day Training will be offered again this fall, on Wednesday's in September. The training will help you understand the relationship history of children & adults from hard places and give you tools to move forward. 23 CEU's. Sept. 7, 14, 21, 28.
